## **Auxiliary Police Officer**

As part of its commitment to partnership with the First Nations Communities served, the Anishinabek Police Service announces an opportunity for dedicated, community-minded volunteers to become Auxiliary Police Officers. This is a VOLUNTEER position with the Anishinabek Police Service Organization.

**The position has been designed to assist the applicant in realizing the requirements for a Constable position with the Anishinabek Police Service.**

### **Duties may include, but are not limited to:**

- Crowd management at parades and special events
- Searches for missing person and large scale searches for evidence
- Preservation of crime scenes at disaster sites
- Acting as a support unit during major emergencies or disasters
- Assistance in RIDE, Marine, and special traffic enforcement programs
- Participation in regular ride-along training programs
- Handling of promotional and public education material
- Assist with Community Policing programs
- And other functions assigned by the Police Chief or his designate.

### **Minimum requirements**

- Be an Anishinabek citizen, or if not available, a citizen of Canada
- Be at least 18 years of age
- Have successfully completed 4 years of High School, or are willing to obtain an Ontario Secondary School Diploma or Equivalent(GED)
- Be of good moral character and habits, with no criminal record for which a pardon has not been granted
- Possess an Ontario Drivers Licence with no more than 6 demerit points
- Hold current certification in First Aid and Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation(CPR)
- Meet minimum vision requirements

- Meet medical requirements
- Be physically fit

## **Selection Process:**

1. Will reflect the principles of equal opportunity
2. Will require the applicant to undergo interview process
3. Will require the applicant to undergo a background check
4. Will require the applicant to undergo a medical examination
5. Will require the applicant to undergo a vision and hearing test

Knowledge of the Police Services structure, functions and activities

Knowledge of software applications and computers

Knowledge and understanding of community, culture and tradition

Ability to work independently and as a team member

Ability to maintain confidentiality a must

Must have proficient oral and written communication skills

Successful applicants will be expected to undergo an initial police-training period of forty hours. Thereafter, Auxiliary Police Officers will be required to volunteer at least 10 hours a month.

## **Application Procedure:**

A complete package including a cover letter, resume, APS Auxiliary application with three references, and waiver form.
