SUMMARY

Responsible to the Police Chief, under the direction of the Detachment Commander, the Police Constable will maintain law and order in a community based setting in order to establish peace and harmony within and around the designated territory.

DUTIES

- Preserving the peace
- Participating in community events and cultural gatherings
- Preventing crimes and other offences and providing assistance and encouragement to other persons by:
 - a) preventing accidents and promote safe use of vehicles and vessels
 - b) conducting preventive patrols and intervening in disturbances to restore the peace
 - c) participating in crime prevention activities, school visits, public education and making referrals to appropriate social agencies
 - d) providing advice on building and property security
- Assisting victims of crime

- Apprehending criminals, offenders and others who may lawfully be taken into custody
- Laying of charges and participate in prosecutions and executing Warrants and performing related duties
- Serving summonses, subpoenas and other court documents related to offences under relevant First Nation, Federal and Provincial Laws
- Performing the lawful duties that the Police Chief assigns
- Attending prescribed training and seminars as directed by the Police Chief
- Conducting investigations into reported occurrences with primary jurisdiction within its territory
- Searching for missing persons and providing assistance to other police services
- Such other duties, not inconsistent with the above, as the Police Chief should direct

QUALIFICATIONS

- Grade 12 graduate
- Must have successfully completed Probationary Constable Course/Basic Constable Level II at Ontario Police College and hold an OPC certificate.
- Must have valid Ontario driver's license, CPR and Standard First Aid Certificate
- Must meet medical and vision requirements
- Must be willing to sign an authorization of release of background information
- Knowledge of First Nation, Provincial and Federal laws and statutes
- Knowledge of the Anishinabek Police Service structure and activities
- Knowledge and understanding of community language, culture and tradition and high sensitivity to Native issues
- Knowledge of the Indian Act
- Good public relation skills
- Ability to maintain confidentiality a must
- Good analytical, organizational and communication skills
- Ability to cope with difficult situations
- Ability to work shift
- Good physical condition
- Be of good moral character with no criminal record
- Preference will be given to First Nation persons

TERMS OF EMPLOYMENT

This position is a permanent position. The anticipated start date is as soon as possible. The successful candidate must pass a background check. In addition, the candidate must provide an Authorization for Release of Information form. Also medical and vision forms must be filled out. Candidates must complete an Anishinabek Police Service application for employment form, along with a resume with 3 references. Candidates must also be willing to reside in the vicinity and be available on their rest days for possible call back to duty.
